## WSTS Poster Presentation Review Form

<b>A. Abstract:</b> Technical posters may not contain an abstract, so refer to the abstract book. The abstract should be clear and concise. It should set the context, contain the objective(s), methods, results, and conclusions or recommendations.	
<b>B. Statement of Research/Intellectual Merit:</b> The questions, hypotheses or objectives are well explained and justified. The relationship of the project to the state of knowledge within the discipline should be clear. References are cited appropriately.	
<b>C. Methods:</b> Clear description of methods. Methods were appropriate to address the project goals.	
<b>D. Analysis / Results:</b> Figures/tables are used appropriately and clearly to present the data; findings are presented accurately and analysis explained/applied.	
<b>E. Conclusions:</b> Conclusions address the study's problem or question and are supported by the results. What new learning, technical development or new knowledge the project produced should be clear.	
<b>F. Significance:</b> Results are likely to contribute to the advancement of scientific knowledge.	
<b>G. Commercial Relevance:</b> The research shows a high potential for impact on the economy through technology transfer, innovation, new business or job creation.	___ x 2 = ___
<b>H. Presentation Quality and Clarity:</b> The poster is aesthetically pleasing and highly legible. Any figures are high quality and clearly labeled (captioned). The poster is organized in a manner that allows the viewer to navigate through the content logically and efficiently. Oral discussions should also be clear and show the presenter's understanding of their work.
